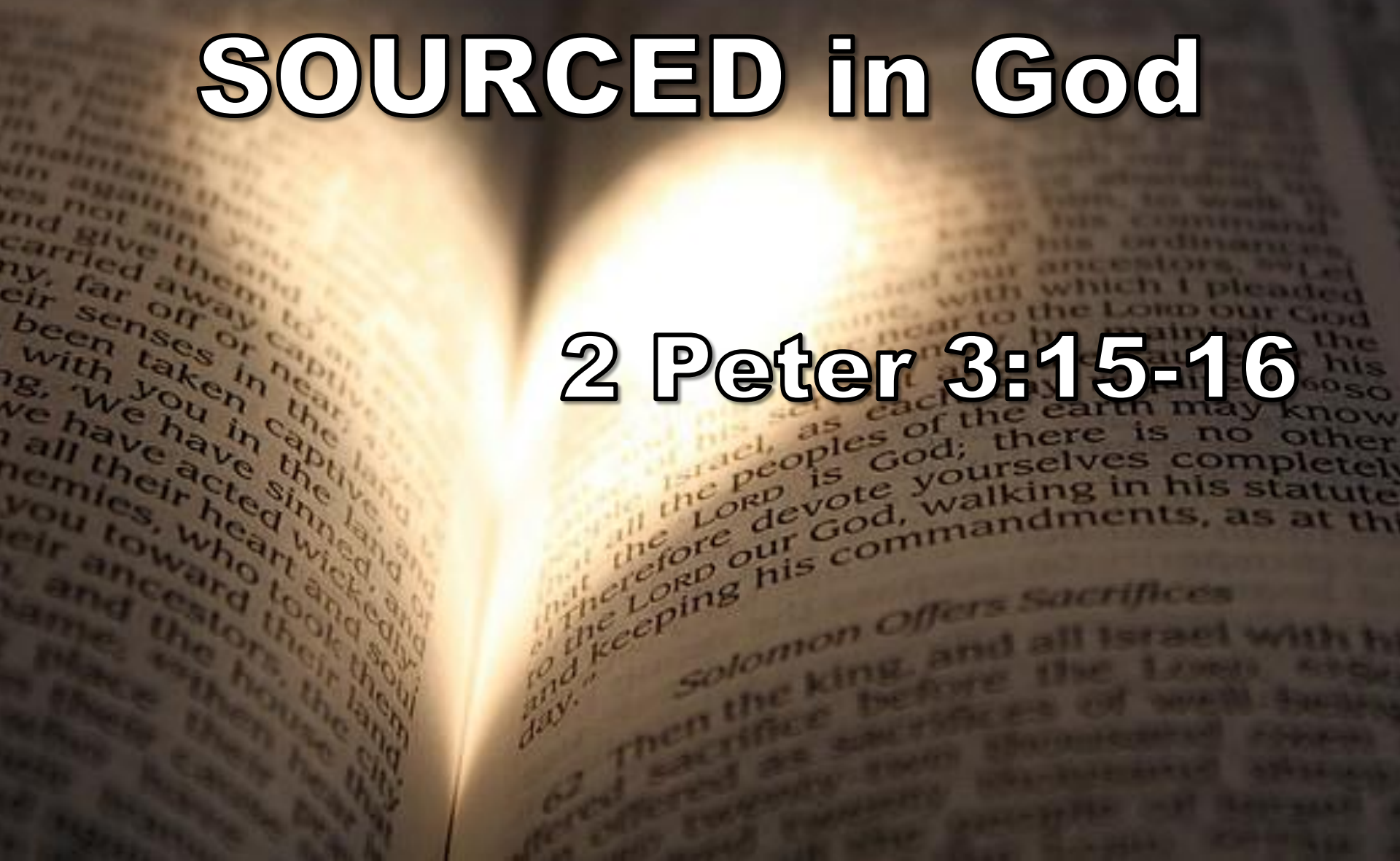

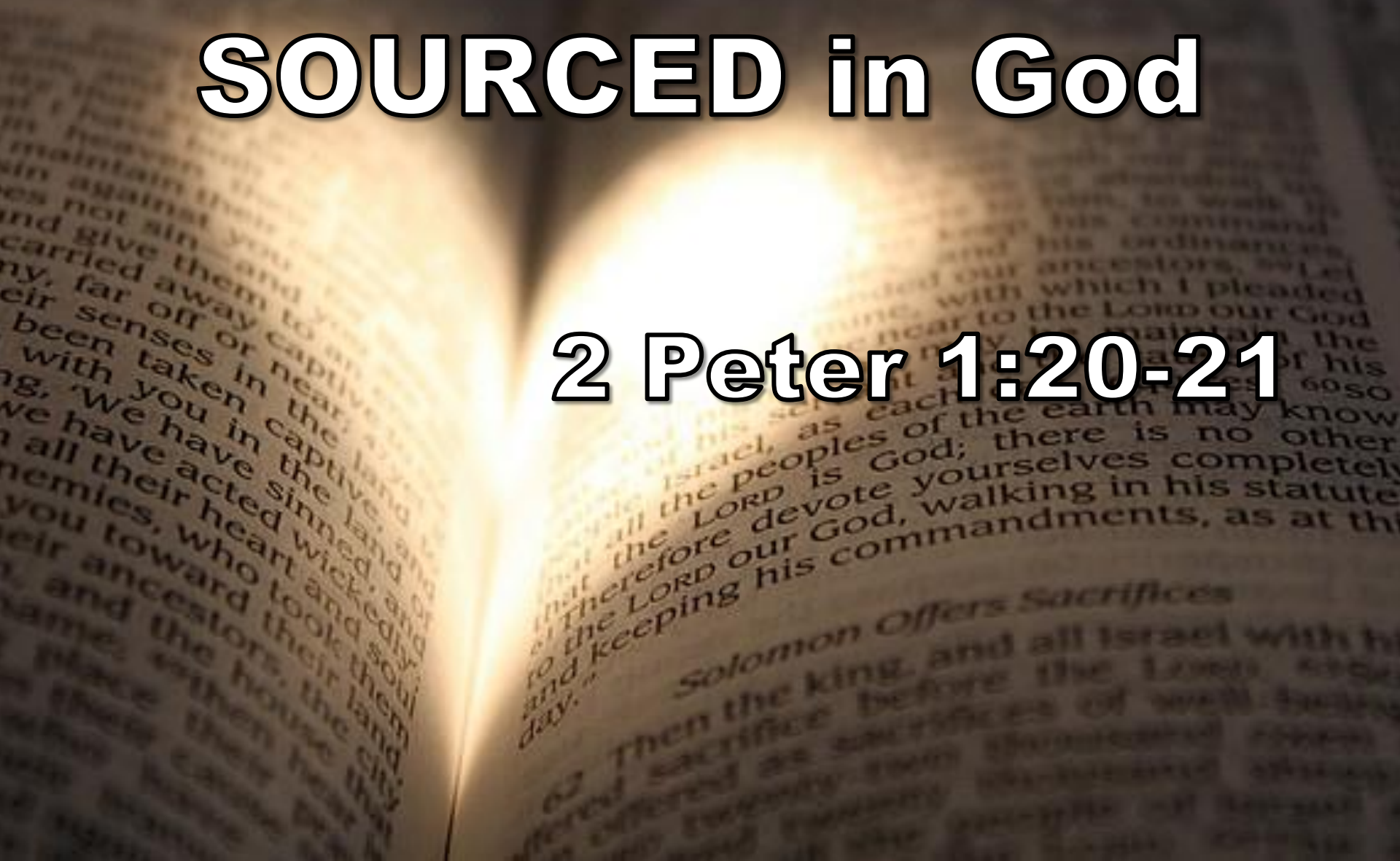

The LORD  
disciplines the nations, does he not  
rebuke?  
The LORD  
teaches man knowledge—  
the LORD—knows the thoughts of man,  
they are but a breath.  
Who is the man whom you discipline,  
O LORD,  
and whom you teach out of your law,  
and give him rest from days of trouble,  
until a pit is dug for the wicked,  
the LORD will not forsake his people;  
he will not abandon his heritage.  
His justice will return to the righteous,  
and all the upright in heart will follow it.  
Who rises up for me against the wicked?  
Who stands up for me against evildoers?  
If the LORD had not been my help,  
my soul would soon have lived in the land  
of silence.  
When I thought, "My foot slips,"  
your steadfast love, O LORD, held me up.  
When the cares of my heart are many,

and condemn the innocent to death.  
But the LORD has become my stronghold,
