Colossians 1:3-8

Errors at Colosse

Gnosticism: A variety of second-century AD religions whose participants believed that people could only be saved through revealed knowledge, or γνῶσις. Gnostics also held a negative view of the physical or material world.

Errors at Colosse

Asceticism: A lifestyle characterized by few possessions or luxuries. It is an attempt to focus one's life on religious or spiritual matters and to not be distracted by things of the world.

Errors at Colosse

Ritualism: The finding religious comfort from customs, ceremonies, modern day examples are found in Roman Catholicism, Orthodox Churches, etc.

Errors at Colosse

Dualism: A philosophical doctrine which holds that mind and matter are distinct, equally real, and not essentially related.

Errors at Colosse

Bad Philosophy: systems of thought or reason that lead you away from God's redemptive person and plan.
